

ORDINANCE NO. 174

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DISORDERLY CONDUCT  
WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF ORWIGSBURG; AND PRE-  
SCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Borough Council and Mayor of the Borough of Orwigsburg, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. All disorderly conduct is hereby prohibited within the Borough of Orwigsburg.

Section 2. Any person who shall by any act, word or conduct which causes or tends to cause a disturbance of the peace and good order of the Borough of Orwigsburg, or which causes or tends to cause any danger, discomfort or annoyance to any of the inhabitants of the Borough or users of the Borough thoroughfares; or who shall wilfully make any loud, boisterous or unseemly noise or disturbance, or cause the same to be done by the operation of any motor vehicle in such a manner as to cause unseemly noises or disturbances, shall be guilty of disorderly conduct.

Section 3. Any person who shall fight or quarrel or incite others to fight or quarrel; or who shall publicly make use of obscene or indecent language; or who shall loaf or loiter or congregate upon any of the public streets or alleys or public grounds within the Borough of Orwigsburg, to the annoyance of peaceable residents nearby or traveling upon any street or alley, or being lawfully upon any of the public grounds of the borough, whereby the public peace is broken or disturbed or the traveling public annoyed, shall be guilty of disorderly conduct.

Section 4. Any person who shall prowl about a dwelling house or business place, without just or proper cause, shall be guilty of disorderly conduct.

Section 5. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this

ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before a Justice of the Peace of the Borough of Orwigsburg, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Ten ( \$10.00 ) Dollars and the costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of such fine and costs to imprisonment in the County Prison for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

Section 6. Any ordinance or part of an ordinance conflicting with this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.

Section 7. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Town Council and the Mayor of the Borough of Orwigsburg that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included therein.
