ORDINANCE NO. 183

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ORWIGSBURG, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING AND RESTRICTING OUTDOOR FIRES WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF ORWIGSBURG, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Orwigsburg, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. No person or persons shall set or maintain any fire upon any of the streets, sidewalks, alleys or public grounds in the Borough of Orwigsburg, or burn or cause to be burned thereon any paper, boxes, rubbish, leaves or other material or substance of any kind.

Section 2. Out-of-door fires shall be permitted, upon private property, provided that each fire shall be built in and confined to a non-combustible container, covered with a screen of one-half inch (1/2") or smaller mesh, or with other suitable non-combustible container. No such fire shall be closer than ^{TEN (10)} ~~thirty (30)~~ feet from any building. No such fire shall be allowed to burn upon any day, except between the hours of 7:00 A. M. and 9:00 P. M.

Section 3. No person or persons shall burn any garbage or other substance, the burning of which will cause disagreeable or offensive odors, at any time or at any place within the borough limits.

Section 4. The burning of brush or grass on an open field or lot is permitted, provided, permission is first secured from the Fire Chief.

Section 5. Any person who shall violate or fail to conform to any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Thirty ((\$30.00)) Dollars and the cost of prosecution and in default of the payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the County Prison for a period not exceeding ten (10) days.

Section 6. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts of ordinances or resolutions, insofar as they are inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 7. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council and the Mayor of the Borough of Orwigsburg, that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included therein.

ENACTED and ORDAINED into an ordinance this 10th day of April, A. D., 1968, by the Council of the Borough of Orwigsburg, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, in lawful session duly assembled.
