ORDINANCE NO. 190

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ORWIGSBURG ESTABLISHING CERTAIN STREETS AS PUBLIC STREETS; SETTING FORTH THE CARTWAY WIDTH AND RIGHT-OF-WAY WIDTH THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Orwigsburg, in council duly assembled, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. That the following streets in the Borough of Orwigsburg are hereby ordained, established, adopted and opened as official public streets of said Borough and they shall be called and known by the names hereinafter ascribed to them and shall have the right-of-way and cartway widths as hereinafter set forth for the distance herein set forth.

1. Church Street - Walborn St. to Lawrence St.
2950 feet - 25 ft. right-of-way 20 ft. cartway
2. Cherry Street - Lincoln Ave. to Straub Ave.
500 feet - 25 ft. right-of-way 20 ft. cartway
3. Cherry Street - Long Avenue to Washington Street
2315 feet - 25 ft. right-of-way 20 ft. cartway
4. Stephens Street - Franklin St. to Washington St.
1850 feet - 25 ft. right-of-way 20 ft. cartway
5. Grant Street - Franklin St. to Wayne St.
1200 feet - 25 ft. right-of-way 20 ft. cartway
6. Harmon St. - Cherry St. to Mifflin St.
200 feet - 40 ft. right-of-way 25 ft. cartway
7. Perry Street - Mifflin Street North 550 feet
8. Long Avenue - Market Street to Industrial Ave.
1650 ft. - 50 ft. right-of-way 36 ft. cartway
10. Marshall Drive - Ridge Road North 450 ft.
450 ft. - 50 ft. right-of-way 50 ft. cartway

11. Eisenhower Dr. - Marshall Dr. to Pershing Dr.
540 ft - 50 ft. right-of-way 50 ft. cartway.

Section 2. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts of ordinances or resolutions, insofar as they are inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council and the Mayor of the Borough of Orwigsburg, that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included therein.
