ORDINANCE NO. 205

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ORWIGSBURG,
ELECTING TO JOIN THE COMMONWEALTH OF
PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL POLICE RETIREMENT
SYSTEM; AGREEING TO BE BOUND BY ALL OF THE
EXISTING AND FUTURE REQUIREMENTS AND PRO-
VISIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL POLICE RETIREMENT
LAW AS APPLICABLE TO MEMBER MUNICIPALITIES.

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Orwigsburg, in council duly assembled, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Orwigsburg hereby elects to become a member of the Police Retirement System of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania established by the Act of the General Assembly on July 31, 1968, No. 291, and does hereby agree to be bound by all of the requirements and provisions of said act and to assume all obligations, financial and otherwise, placed upon member municipalities by said act.

Section 2. The Borough of Orwigsburg does hereby incorporate the said Municipal Police Retirement Law as a part of this ordinance without setting it forth in full herein, insofar as said act, as amended, applies to a member municipality.

Section 3. A duly certified copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the Municipal Employees Retirement Board. Membership for the Borough of Orwigsburg in the Municipal Police Retirement System shall be effective the first day of May, 1971.

Section 4. Any ordinance or part of an ordinance conflicting with this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.

Section 5. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council and the Mayor of the Borough of Orwigsburg that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included therein.
