ORDINANCE NO. 250

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE  
BOROUGH OF ORWIGSBURG, FIXING THE  
TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1983

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Orwigsburg, in council duly assembled, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same, as follows:

Section 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property within the said borough, subject to taxation for borough purposes for the fiscal year 1983 as follows:

The rate for General Borough Purposes is the sum of six (6) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

Section 2. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all occupations within the said borough, subject to taxation for borough purposes for the fiscal year 1983 as follows:

The rate for General Borough Purposes is the sum of thirteen (13) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

Section 3. All taxpayers subject to the payment of taxes, assessed by the taxing district, shall be entitled to a discount of two per centum from the amount of such tax upon making payment of the whole amount thereof within two months after the date of the tax notice. All taxpayers, who shall fail to make payment of such taxes charged against them for four months after the date of the tax notice, shall be charged a penalty of ten per centum which penalty shall be added to the taxes by the tax collector and be collected by him.

Section 4. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts of ordinances or resolutions, insofar as they are inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 5. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council of the Borough of Orwigsburg that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included therein.
