ORDINANCE NO. 204

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE IV,  
SECTION 10, OF ORDINANCE NO. 177 OF THE  
BOROUGH OF ORWIGSBURG, ORDAINED, EN-  
ACTED AND APPROVED OCTOBER 6, 1967;  
PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR PARKING  
VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Orwigsburg, in council duly assembled, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. Section 10, Article IV of Ordinance No. 177 of the Borough of Orwigsburg, duly enacted, ordained and approved October 6, 1967, is hereby amended so that the same shall read as follows:

"Section 10. Penalties.

Any person who shall park his motor vehicle in violation of any section of Article IV hereof shall be notified by a tag to be placed on the windshield of said motor vehicle by the Mayor or any of the Police Officers of the borough, which card shall indicate the time and place of the violation, the license number of the vehicle involved in the violation, and any other facts which may be necessary to describe the violation. The Police Officer shall report to the Mayor concerning the violation. Said tag or card to be placed on the windshield of the violating motor vehicle shall contain a notice advising the owner or operator to report to the Office of the Mayor within forty-eight (48) hours of the time when the

notice was attached to said vehicle and to pay to the Mayor, as a penalty for the violation thereof, the sum of Two ( \$2.00 ) Dollars or may remit by mail to the Mayor said tag and the sum of Two ( \$2.00 ) Dollars, within forty-eight (48) hours of the violation.

Any person violating any of the sections of Article IV hereof, and who shall not have remitted the fine in accordance with Article IV, Section 10 hereof, shall be prosecuted before a Justice of the Peace of the Borough of Orwigsburg and shall upon conviction thereof be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Two ( \$2.00 ) Dollars, nor more than Fifty Dollars, and the costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of such fine or costs, to undergo imprisonment in the County Prison for a period not exceeding ten (10) days. Provided, however, that the payment of the sum of Two ( \$2.00 ) Dollars to the Mayor, within the time limit and under the circumstances hereinabove provided, shall save from prosecution any person making such payment. "

Section 2. Any ordinance or part of an ordinance conflicting with this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.

Section 3. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council and the Mayor of the Borough of Orwigsburg that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence,

clause, section or part thereof not been included therein.
