ORDINANCE NO. 220

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF ORWIGSBURG, SCHUYLKILL
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING A
SPEED LIMIT ON ALL BOROUGH STREETS,
ONE-WAY STREETS, AND PROVIDING FOR
PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF,
AND FURTHER AMENDING THE PARKING AND
TRAFFIC ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF
ORWIGSBURG, NO. 177, ADOPTED AND
APPROVED THE 6TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1967.

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Borough Council and the Mayor of the Borough of Orwigsburg, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

ARTICLE I

UNIFORM SPEED LIMIT

Section 1. No person shall operate a motor vehicle on any street within the Borough of Orwigsburg, not a State highway, in excess of a speed greater than twenty-five (25) miles an hour. Notice of such speed limit shall be given by the posting of signs on the right-hand side of the street facing the traffic to be controlled, or on the left-hand side of one-way streets.

Section 2. The speed limitation set forth hereinabove shall not apply to vehicles, when operated with due regard for safety, under the direction of the police in the chase or apprehension of violators of the law, or of persons charged with or suspected of any such violation, or to fire department or fire patrol vehicles when traveling in response to a fire alarm, nor to ambulances when traveling in emergencies.

Section 3. Any person violating the provisions of this Article shall, upon summary conviction before a magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment in the County prison for a period not exceeding five (5) days.

ARTICLE II

ONE-WAY STREETS

Section 1. The following streets, or sections thereof, are hereby designated as "One-Way Streets" and all vehicular traffic approaching said streets, or sections thereof, shall proceed in the directions designated by official signs:

- (a) Cherry Street- From East to West between North Wayne Street and North Liberty Street.
- (b) Sherman Street-From North to South between East Market Street and Independence Street.

Section 2. Official "ONE WAY" signs shall be erected on the sections of the aforesaid streets as above designated by the Borough of Orwigsburg.

Section 3. Any person who shall operate a motor vehicle in violation of the provisions of this Article shall, upon summary conviction before a magistrate be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and costs of prosecution and in default of payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment in the County prison for a period not exceeding five (5) days.

ARTICLE III

PARKING

Section 1. That Article IV, Section 4, of the Ordinance of the Borough of Orwigsburg, duly enacted and approved the 6th day of October, 1967, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsection:

- (a) Official "Two Hour Parking" signs shall be erected on said Market Street between Washington Street and Franklin Streets.

Section 2. All other provisions of Article IV, Section 4, of the Oruinance adopted and approved the 6th day of October, 1967, as amended by Ordinance No. 204 adopted and approved the 10th day of March, 1971, are hereby re-enacted and shall remain in full force and effect, including the penalty provisions there

ARTICLE IV

Section 1. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts of ordinances or resolutions insofar as the same are inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 2. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council of the Borough of Orwigsburg that this ordinance would heve been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not be included therein.

This Ordinance shall become effective the 11th day of December, A.D. 1974 or upon such time as official signs shall be erected on the streets affected by any of the section of this Ordinance.

ENACTED and ORDAINED into an Ordinance this 11th day of December, A.D. 1974, by the Council of the Borough of Orwigsburg, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, in lawful session duly assembled.
