ORDINANCE NO. 267

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ORWIGSBURG, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 175 TO PROHIBIT ON-LOT SEWERAGE IN THE BOROUGH OF ORWIGSBURG AND TO PROVIDE THAT ALL CURBS SHALL BE OF THE VERTICAL TYPE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Orwigsburg, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 410 of Ordinance No. 175 relating to Sewer Facilities be and hereby is amended as follows:

Within an area of the Borough having a public sewer system which is, in the judgment of the Commission, based on a sewerage feasibility study, reasonably accessible to the subdivision and available for connection thereto, the subdivision shall be provided with a complete sanitary sewer system to be connected to the public sanitary sewer system.

In all new subdivisions, all lots or parcels shall be connected to the public or community sanitary sewerage system.

In all new subdivisions, on-lot sewerage disposal system, or as defined herein Individual sewerage systems are hereby prohibited. The purpose of this ordinance, "Individual sewerage system" means a system of piping, tanks or other facilities serving a single lot and collecting and disposing of sewerage in

whole or in part into the soil or into any waters of the Borough or by means of conveyance to another site for final disposal.

All sanitary sewer systems proposed shall conform to the requirements to the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act No. 537 of December 22, 1968.

Where a local, county or regional comprehensive plan indicates that construction or extension of sanitary sewers may serve the subdivision area within a reasonable time, the Borough Planning Commission shall require the installation and capping of sanitary sewer mains. Responsibility for the design and supervision of installation of all capped sewers, laterals and house connections shall be that of the Borough. In all cases, sanitary sewerage disposal facilities shall be provided for every lot or parcel by a complete community or public sanitary system.

SECTION 2. Section 612 of Ordinance No. 175 relating to curbs, and hereby is amended as follows:

Curbs shall be required in subdivisions which have a typical lots width at the buildings--back line of 200' or less. Curbs shall be of the vertical type. All curbs are to be constructed of cement concrete, and shall be constructed in accordance with specifications of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 4. If any sentence, clause section, or part this ordinance for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or

invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not effect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 5. Effective Date: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption, following a public hearing.
