ORDINANCE NO. 277

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ORWIGSBURG AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 216 RELATING TO SANITATION AND FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Orwigsburg, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, in council duly assembled, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Part A. of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 216 be and hereby is amended as follows:

Section 1. Definitions

- (a) Garbage means animal and vegetable waste and grass clippings and leaves. It shall not include more than a minimum amount of free liquids. It shall not include food-processing wastes from canneries, packing plants or similar industries, nor large quantities of condemned food products.

SECTION 2. Section 6 of Ordinance No. 216 be and hereby is amended as follows:

Section 6. Each person for whom the said contractor shall collect refuse shall place said refuse in sanitary covered cans made of non-absorbent material, provided with handles and closely fitted covers, or bags not larger than 33 gallons of such type that can be tied. Containers or bags must be capable of being emptied by one person. Such containers or bags shall be furnished by the customer. Containers shall be cleaned by him following each collection and shall be replaced by such person when no longer in good condition. All combustible refuse shall be assembled, boxed or bundled separately in

such a way that it can be handled conveniently and will not be disseminated by wind or otherwise while awaiting collection. All incombustible refuse shall be in units that can be handled by one person and shall be placed in containers or piled and assembled in such a way so as to facilitate collection. All refuse shall be placed for collection at the curb line of the properties of the owners. The contractor herein designated shall not be required to convey any building rubbish from building construction or reconstruction or razing thereof, street refuse, industrial refuse, dead animals, abandoned machinery or vehicles and equipment of any kind, or such other waste materials as are not commonly produced in homes, stores and institutions.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or Resolutions or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions insofar as they are consistent herewith being the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
