ORDINANCE NO. 425

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ORWIGSBURG, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY ORDINANCE NO. 257 WHICH CREATED CERTAIN RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERS OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE BOROUGH; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEALERS, SEVERABILITY AND THE EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Borough Council and the Mayor of the Borough of Orwigsburg, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

101. Repeal of Ordinance No. 257. Borough Ordinance No. 257, adopted February 13, 1985, which created certain residency requirements for members of the Police Department of the Borough of Orwigsburg is hereby repealed in its entirety and is no longer in force or effect.

102: Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


103: Severability. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

104: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with applicable law.
